## CHERRY BLOSSOM

Jun Chiyabari Estate, Nepal

*Collected from a single tree high up in the Himalayas, tea from Jun Chiyabari or 'Moonlit Tea Garden' comes from small plots between 1,650 and 2,200 metres above sea level. Within and between these small plots on the hilly slopes are forests, bamboo groves, rocky boulders, brooks and streams - forming the terroir from which the tea is created. Warm marzipan, cherry, almonds and a hint of hay.*
